

#### Scholastic Area

#### **Annual Examination - 80 Marks**

- Board will conduct Class X Annual Examination for 80 marks (3 hours duration) in each subject covering 100% syllabus.
- Marks and Grades both will be awarded for individual subjects.
- 9 point grading will be followed.
- Student has to secure 33% marks out of 80 marks in each subject.

## Board Examination for (Class X) and Annual Examination (class IX) for 80 marks for Class X:

 The Board Examination in each subject will cover entire syllabus of Class-X. Grades corresponding to the marks shall be on the basis of 9point grading system. Grades will be awarded in each scholastic subject. For awarding the grades, the Board will put all the passed students in a rank order and will award the grades as follows:

#### Remodeled Assessment Structure for Class IX & X 2023 - 24 Introduction of skill subjects

- The Scheme of Studies for the students opting for skill subjects in classes IX-X is as follows:
- If a student fails in any of the three compulsory subjects (i.e., Science, Mathematics and Social Science) and has passed in Al, then the Al marks will replace the subject mark and will be considered for passing criteria.
- If a student studies three compulsory subjects (i.e., Science, Mathematics and Social Science) and also chooses to study a Skill subject (offered as sixth optional subject), then the aggregate of best five including two languages and the best three subjects (from subject 3, 4, 5 & 6,including Skill subject) can be considered for calculation of percentage (by the school).



# Differently Abled Students Medical Certificate

#### The medical certificate must be issued by

- Disability Certificate(s) issued by Government hospitals controlled by either the Central or State Governments;
- Disability Certificate(s) issued by Recognized institutes of national level viz National Association for the Blind, Spastic Society of India etc; and
- Disability Certificate(s) issued by Non-governmental Organizations/practitioners registered with Rehabilitation Council of India/Central Government/State Government of the Respective State.

## Exemptions/Concessions being extended to Differently Abled Candidates

#### √ Scribe and compensatory time

Paper Duration	Extra Time
3 hrs	60 min
2½ hours	50 min
2 hours	40 min
1½ hours	30 min

- ✓ Exemption from examination in the third language from Classes VI to VIII
- √ Flexibility in choosing subjects

Besides one language any four of the following subjects be offered".

Mathematics, Science, Social Science, another language, Music, Painting, Home Science, Foundation of Information Technology, Commerce(Elements of Business), Commerce(Elements of Book Keeping and Accountancy)

- ✓ Alternate questions/Separate Question Paper for Visually Impaired Students
- **✓** Other General instructions/ facilities
